



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
MANIPUR UNIVERSITY
AND**



INDIAN INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY MANIPUR

1. Objectives

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) describes the joint efforts of the Indian Institute of Information Technology Senapati, Manipur (IIIT Manipur), Ministry of Education, Government of India, at Mantripukhri, Imphal, Manipur-795002 and Manipur University (MU), Manipur University (Central University), Ministry of Education, Government of India at Canchipur, Imphal, Manipur - 795003 (collectively, the Parties or Institutions) to advance academic excellence and research.


Taking into account the shared interests of both parties, the parties agree to embrace the following objectives as part of this collaboration.

- i. It will encourage scholarly collaboration, knowledge exchange, and creative research, which will promote interdisciplinary and holistic research collaboration between MU and IIIT Manipur.
- ii. To share knowledge about research and educational initiatives.
- iii. To share knowledge about teaching, learning materials, and other works of literature that are pertinent to their research and teaching initiatives.
- iv. To work together in organizing seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite faculty members from each other's institutions to participate.
- v. To collaboratively suggest and participate in research or training initiatives supported by funding organizations and to extend invitations to each other's faculty members to take part in such endeavours.
- vi. To exchange laboratory facilities for limited periods for teaching and/or research on a reciprocal basis, depending on requirements and availability at the Undergraduate, Postgraduate, and Doctorate levels.
- vii. Support MU and IIIT Ph.D. students in obtaining doctoral degrees at IIIT Manipur and MU respectively by granting them access to the resources and knowledge available at IIIT and MU.

2. Exchange of Laboratory Facilities

MU and IIIT Manipur will collaborate to support and identify laboratory needs across undergraduate, postgraduate, and research levels. The specifics regarding the use of laboratory facilities will be determined through mutual agreement between MU and IIIT Manipur.





3. Joint Conferences, Workshops and Short-Term Courses

MU and IIIT Manipur will collaborate to assist in identifying and inviting faculty members from various institutions to take part in conferences, workshops, and short-term courses. The specific terms and conditions for their participation will be determined through mutual agreement between MU and IIIT Manipur.

4. Joint Sponsored Research, Development, and Consulting

MU and IIIT Manipur will collaborate to identify and invite faculty members from both institutions to engage in research or development programs. The specific terms and conditions for this participation will be determined through mutual agreement between MU and IIIT Manipur.

5. Exchange of Faculty, Scientists and Staff

Collaboration between faculty and scientists from MU and IIIT Manipur will be encouraged. Institutions will specifically encourage faculty members to take term visiting assignments or short visits to each other's institution following established norms. MU and IIIT Manipur will work out the terms and conditions for each visit or agreement, including those about stipend, travel, housing, and the name of the concerned faculty.

6. Intellectual Property

MU and IIIT Manipur agree to honour each other's intellectual property rights. Additionally, any intellectual property rights arising from collaborative research activities under this MoU will be determined on a case-by-case basis, following the established IPR policies of both institutions.

7. Duration, Review and Termination

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) will start upon signing and will be valid for FIVE (05) years. It will be automatically extended for another THREE (03) years unless either party terminates it with a written notice of THREE (03) months to the other party. If any modifications are needed, both institutions will review the MoU. It may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by THREE (3) months' notice in writing by either party.

8. Cooperation

Both parties share common interests and goals, and they will create communication and cooperation channels to enhance and further their respective activities. They will stay updated on potential opportunities and share relevant information to help secure additional opportunities for each other
